FUND RISKS

The Fund invests in foreign securities which involve political, economic and currency risks, greater volatility and differences in accounting methods. Equity securities (stocks) are generally more volatile and carry more risk than f xed income securities (bonds) and money market investments. The net asset value per share of this Fund will fuctuate as the value of the securities in the portfolio changes. Common stocks, and funds investing in common stocks, generally provide greater returns over long time periods than f xed income securities. The Fund is comprised primarily of equity securities and is subject to market risk. Stocks may decline due to general market and economic conditions or due to company specific circumstances. The Adviser's integration of ESG risks and opportunities and/or active ownership activities may cause the Fund to perform differently from a fund that uses a different methodology. ESG integration may cause the Fund to forego investment opportunities that may otherwise be advantageous.
